

The Cayman Islands Department of Planning (DOP) is committed to protecting your privacy and developing technology that gives you the most powerful and safe online experience. This Statement of Privacy applies to the DOP Web site at dop.secure.ky and governs data collection and usage. By using the DOP website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

1 Collection of your Personal Information

DOP collects personally identifiable information, such as your e-mail address, name, home or work address or telephone number. DOP also collects anonymous demographic information, which is not unique to you, such as your ZIP code, age, gender, preferences, interests and favorites.

There is also information about your computer hardware and software that is automatically collected by Cayman Land Info. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring Web site addresses. This information is used by DOP for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of dop.secure.ky.

DOP encourages you to review the privacy statements of Web sites you choose to link to from dop.secure.ky so that you can understand how those Web sites collect, use and share your information. DOP is not responsible for the privacy statements or other content on Web sites outside of dop.secure.ky.

2 Use of your Personal Information

DOP collects and uses your personal information to operate the [https://dop.secure.ky/](https://dop.secure.ky) website and deliver the services you have requested. DOP reserves the right to also use your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from DOP. DOP also reserves the right to contact you via surveys to conduct research about your opinion of current services or of potential new services that may be offered.

DOP does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties.

DOP keeps track of the Web sites and pages our customers visit within dop.secure.ky, in order to determine what DOP services are the most popular. This data may be used in the future to deliver customized content and advertising within dop.secure.ky to customers whose behavior indicates that they are interested in a particular subject area.

DOP websites will disclose your personal information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on DOP or the site; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of DOP; and, (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of dop.secure.ky, or the public.

3 Security of your Personal Information

DOP secures your credentials from unauthorized access, use or disclosure. DOP secures the credentials you provide on computer servers in a controlled, secure environment, protected from

unauthorized access, use or disclosure. When personal information (such as a credit card number) is transmitted to other Web sites, it is protected through the use of encryption, such as the Secure Socket Layer (SSL) protocol.

4 Use of Cookies

The DOP website uses "cookies" to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a Web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize dop.secure.ky pages, or register with dop.secure.ky, a cookie helps dop.secure.ky to recall your specific information on subsequent visits. This simplifies the process of recording your personal information, and preferences. When you return to the same DOP website, the information you previously provided can be retrieved, so you can easily use the dop.secure.ky features that you customized.

You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. Most Web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. If you choose to decline cookies, you may not be able to fully experience the interactive features of the dop.secure.ky services or other websites you visit.

5 Changes to this Statement

DOP will occasionally update this Statement of Privacy to reflect department and customer feedback. DOP encourages you to periodically review this Statement to be informed of how DOP is protecting your information.
